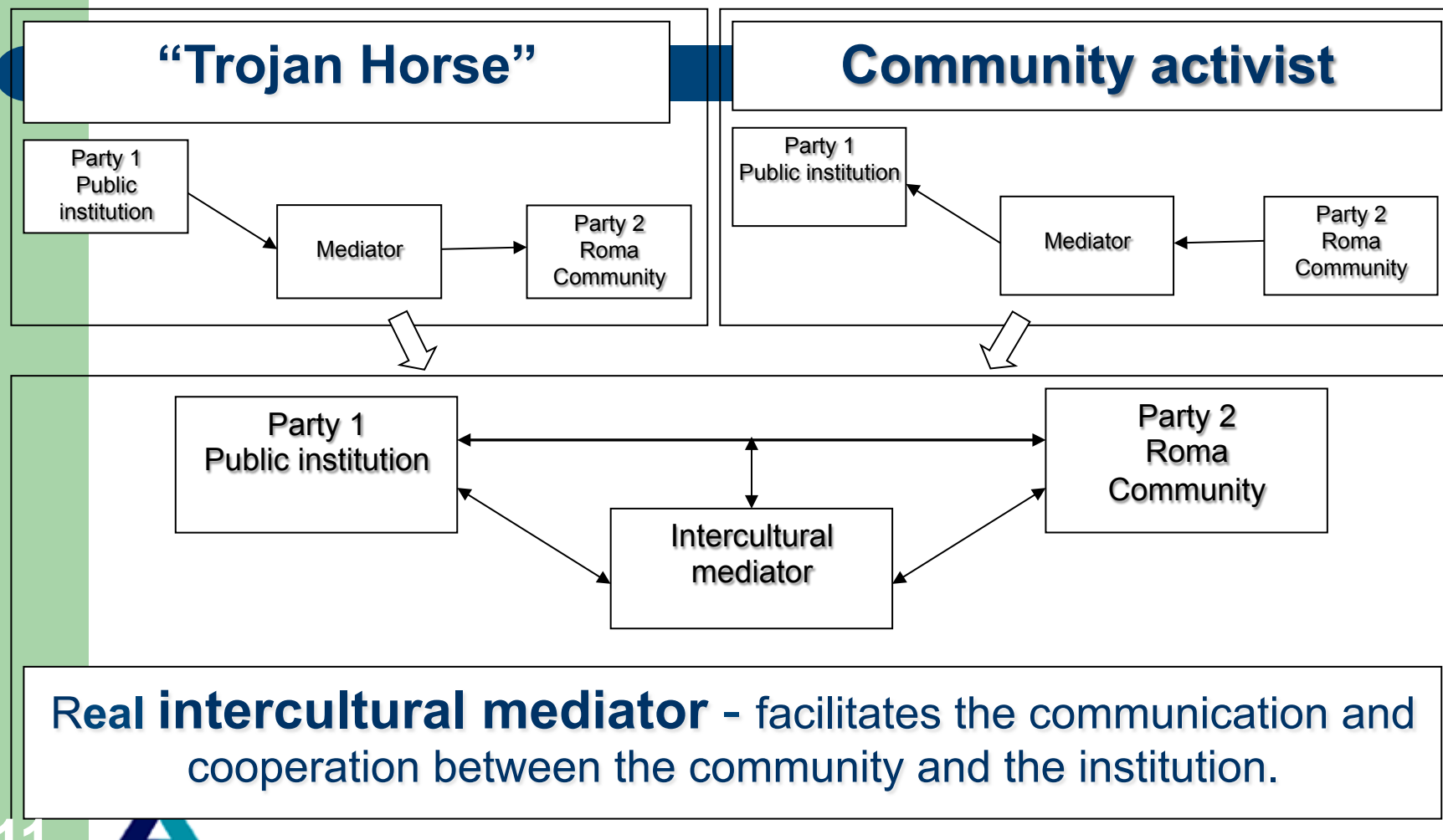


# Types of approach in practice

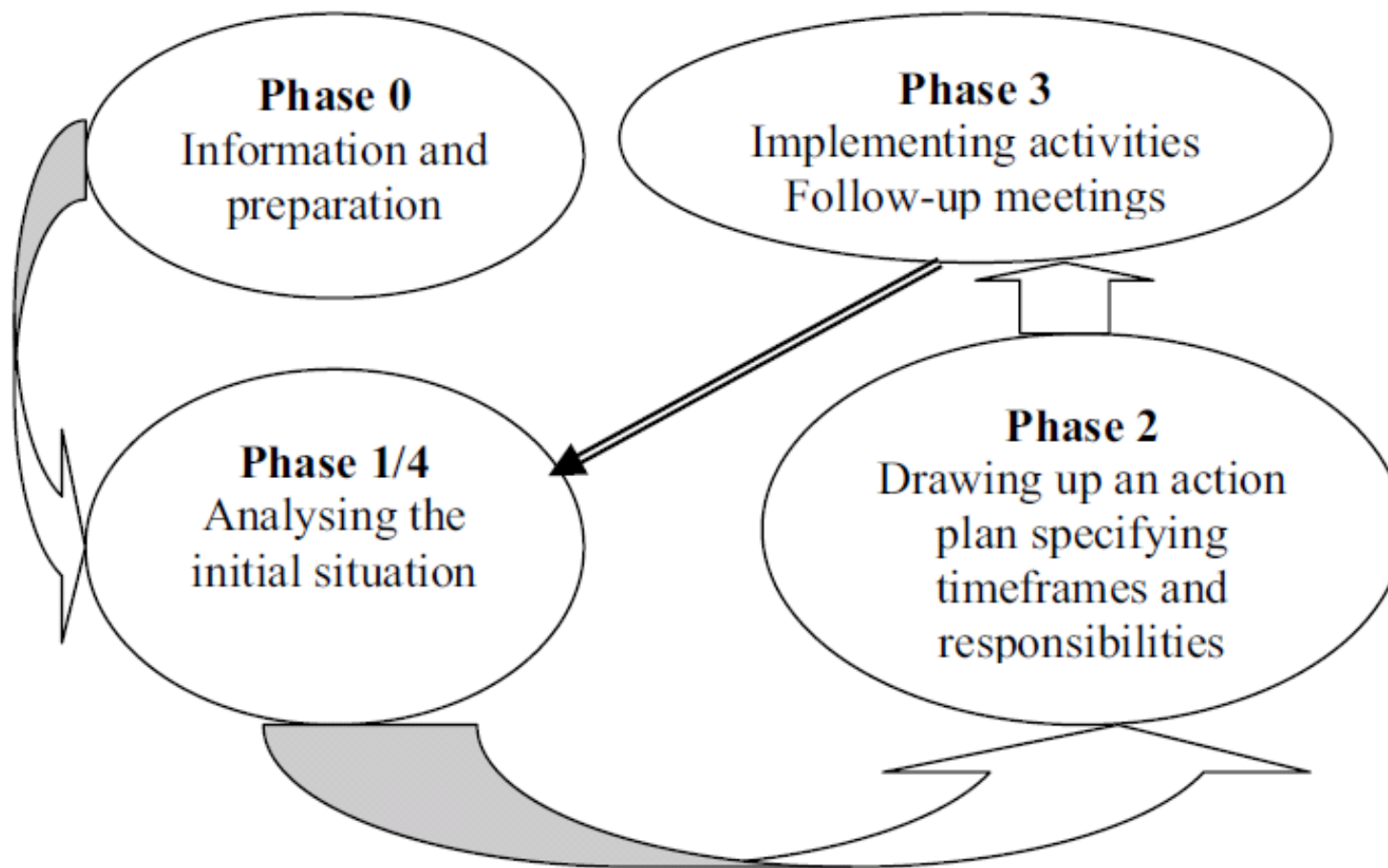
- **The Trojan Horse**  
the mediator is an *instrument of the institution*
- **The community activist**  
fighting *against the institution*, for the rights of the Roma
- ***The real mediator***  
*prevention*, impartial, improving communication and *cooperation*, shared responsibilities, joint problem solving, change
